Through these interracial, facilitated Dialogues you will join with other community members to explore race and racism, respond to enlightening readings, listen carefully to others, deepen your self-awareness, and explore ways to make our communities more equitable for all.

Dialogue Circles have been offered to more than 300 participants in the wider Summit community over the last four years. We have two curricula - Dialogue 1.0 for new participants and "deeper dive" Dialogue 2.0 groups for those who previously participated in a Dialogue Circle. *If you have already participated, please share this information with friends who might be interested.*

If participant sign-ups allow, we hope to offer Dialogue sessions Sunday, Tuesday and Saturday afternoons and Monday and Wednesday evenings.
